Good Afternoon Sheriff Koutoujian,

Reference is made to ICE's Priority Enforcement Program (PEP). As you know, we met with the Massachusetts Sheriff's Association to introduce the program, answer questions, and address your concerns.

As you are now aware, DHS has replaced the Form I-247 (Immigration Detainer – Notice of Action) with two new forms, which address a number of concerns raised by our state and local partners regarding the current detainer form: Form I-247N (Immigration Notification - Request for Information Prior to Release) and Form I-247D (Immigration Detainer – Request for Action). For your convenience, I have attached sample copies of the I-247D, the I-247N and a PEP brochure.

The PEP policy framework provides the foundation from which to develop processes that work for each individual jurisdiction. We are dedicated to working with those jurisdictions that partner with us today. We can best do this by tailoring PEP to fit the needs of each jurisdiction, ensuring that law enforcement is able to maintain community trust while also removing those here illegally who threaten the safety of our communities.

I am now individually reaching out to our law enforcement partners to determine whether or not they will honor ICE's I-247D, the I-247N, both forms, or neither. It would be greatly appreciated if you would let me know.
