Re: ICE I-200 Warrants of Arrest

Dear Mr. Riordan:

Your letter to Sheriff Gore has been referred to me for response. The San Diego County Sheriff's Department has reviewed the concerns set forth in your letter, and has consulted with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. As a result, a determination has been made to handle the Form I-200 Warrant for Arrest of an Alien in the same manner as an I-247 Immigration Detainer.

As with an I-247 Immigration Detainer, an inmate's release will not be delayed based upon the fact that they are subject to the Form I-200 Warrant for Arrest of an Alien. In essence, the Sheriff's Department will treat the I-200 Warrant for Arrest of an Alien as a request by ICE for notification that an inmate's process for release from custody has begun.

I trust the above change will address your significant ongoing concerns.
